



FIBA International Clearance – Process

If your email is in relation to International Clearance please see the following information.

The club requires to process and submit the FIBA Letter of Clearance Form for approval. All Information and Form link to the FIBA LOC Form via

Including FIBA processing time, this can take a minimum of 10-14 working days (not including weekends) if the application contains all the required information,

Summary

Note 1

NON UK Nationals -Under 18, WHO HAVE NEVER PLAYED OUTSIDE OF GB - The CLUB require to complete and upload on the FIBA Letter of Clearance Application form via the web link above, the completed **FIBA Players Declaration Form** and the **FIBA National Team Declaration Form**. Plus **Copy of passport**.

Information - Above does not apply to players who are **Under 14**. **Players who are Under 14** do not need to have FIBA clearance **UNLESS** they have played outside of GB, then **Note 2** below applies.

NON UK Nationals -OVER 18, WHO HAVE NEVER PLAYED OUTSIDE OF GB - The CLUB require to complete and upload the **FIBA Players Declaration Form** Plus **Copy of passport**. FIBA may ask for further information in these cases at their discretion.

****** : in the FIBA National Team Declaration Form LINE 3 – National Team of (is same as citizenship = Spanish then Spain not Club or GB) *******

Note 2 -

For ALL players, aged Under 18, (no matter their nationality) WHO have played outside of GB then the following are required in addition to the Players Passport.

1- the FIBA Players Declaration Form and the - FIBA National Team Declaration Form.1. Letter from parents / guarding confirming that player has approval to play for the club.

2. Letter from School confirming player is enrolled.

3. Letter from Club confirming player is a member of the club

4. Note from Parents/Guardian as to reason why player is in GB e.g. parents work

5. Copy of Players Status to be in GB e.g. Visa or EU Settled status.

These documents should be uploaded with the application form.

See FIBA Regulations Book 3 - Articles 71-88 for more information.

REMEMBER – Above Note 2 Does not apply to players who are Under 14 who do not need to have FIBA clearance UNLESS they have played outside of GB.

ALL FIBA FORMS require to be signed by the player and parent or guardian and if applicable club representative. Typed signatures will be not be accepted. All documents require to be uploaded individually. DO NOT MERGE THEM.
